## NORMAL

Head and face



Feathers and body position



Legs



Cloaca



## SIGNS OF DISEASE

Unexplained dead birds



Diarrhoea / poor cloaca



Feather loss / ruffled feathers



Discharge from the head



Swollen and closed eyes



Lice



Lesions on the face, legs, feet or body



Unwillingness to move / odd body position



## SOUNDS OF DISEASE



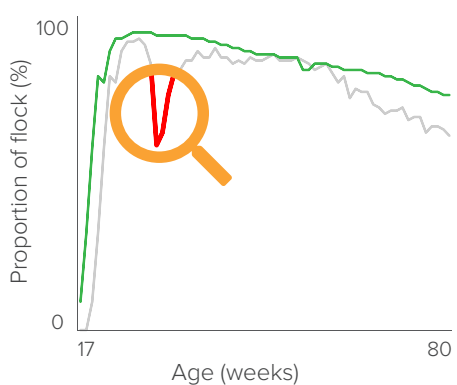
Coughing / Sneezing / Snicking / Gasping  
The birds sound different or are making distressed cries or coughing up mucous



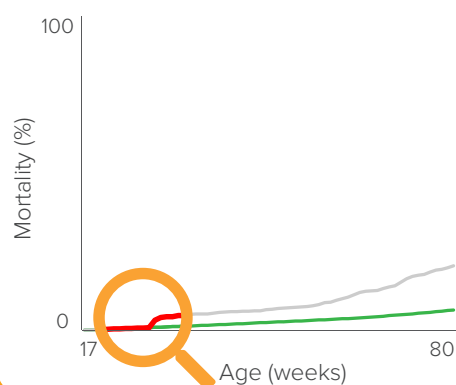
## OTHER DISEASE INDICATORS

These indicators should be monitored on a daily basis to enable early detection of disease

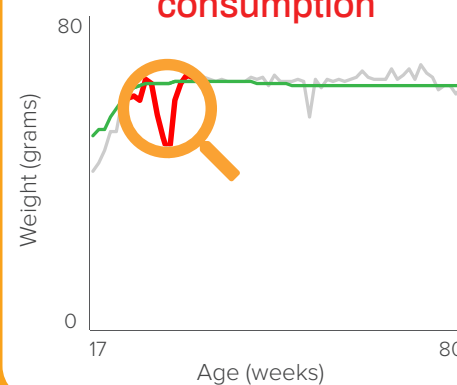
Reduced egg production



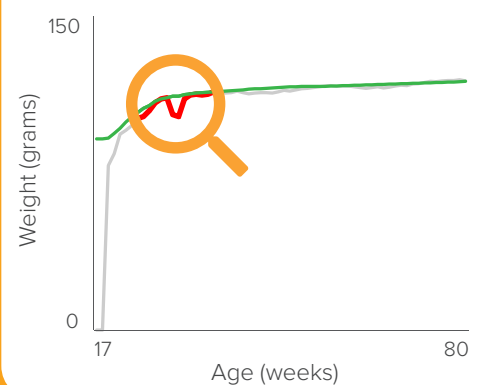
Increased mortality rate



Decrease in feed and water consumption



Decrease in egg weight



Reduced egg quality;  
change in egg white thickness, colour or size
